Grange-Crag Loop Walk

Route: Grange-Crag Loop Walk

Theme: History and Nature; along forestry tracks and woodland trails

Date: Sunday 17 July, 2011

Meeting time: 13.30

Meeting Point: Hogans Pub car park, Grange (via Urlingford 8km or Killenaule / Glengoole (New Birmingham), Co. Tipperary OS Sheet 67, S307564

Length of walk: 6 km

Estimated time of walk: 2 - 2.5 hours

Minimum Gear: Hiking boots, rain gear, snack and fluid

Level of Walk – moderate: Ascent: 310m/150m

The historical Grange-Crag loop, with its Victorian Ice House and Wellington Monument, looks down on Kilcooley Abbey and has views across the whole of Tipperary. This path is definitely off the beaten track and well worth the effort. Just think of that sense of achievement!
