- 1) **Introductions and minutes:** Minutes of previous meeting were adopted
- 2) **Matters Arising:**  
A presentation by Superintendent Paul Moran, Youth and Intimidation were all mentioned as topics for later meetings. Report re County Youth Developments circulated.
- 3) **Action Plan:**  
The Draft Action plan was reviewed and approved, see attached.
- 4) **Intimation**
  1. Small group of youths, 18 years + old, in several of the towns in the county were discussed as was the role of disability payments. Inter-agency work is required in the case of the latter topic. Community houses will provide a very necessary service and there is a need to get kids involved in beneficial activities. Small local projects are needed.
  2. The need for greater and intensive community policing was discussed as were possible ways to assist the GS in this regard.

- 6) A budget for residents associations should be available in each Town Council area to assist them in their environmental, young peoples programmes etc.
